Mark: 7: 31-37

Some thoughts on today's scripture:

Jesus is on the move again, like a Shepherd searching for his stray sheep. All he wants is to heal, and we need healing. We are often deaf to His calls, and we are dumb when we should be witnessing to the Good News. Let us spend a few moments with this man, Jesus, and as we gaze at Him can we hear Him or speak to Him? Do we feel Jesus' fingers in our ears and on our tongues? Suddenly the world of sound opens up to us. We praise Him for His goodness to us. When we were baptised our ears and tongues were blessed, so that we could hear God's word and praise God. We ask the Lord to renew these gifts we were given but then may have left unused.

BAPTISM

To request a baptism for your child you need to come along to Sunday Mass at 11.00am at St Anthony of Padua (or 9.30am at Our Lady and St Columba.) If you do not already regularly attend Mass then after doing so for a few weeks, please introduce yourself to Fr David Smith and, if appropriate, you will be given a baptism application form. Once the form is returned you will be given a date to attend for a baptism catechesis session. Once that is completed then you will be offered dates from which you can choose the most suitable for your family. Please be understanding and respectful during this process.
